

## Pact South Africa: Building Community Capacity to Respond to HIV&AIDS Challenges

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#### Pact South Africa Program (October 2007 – September 2012)

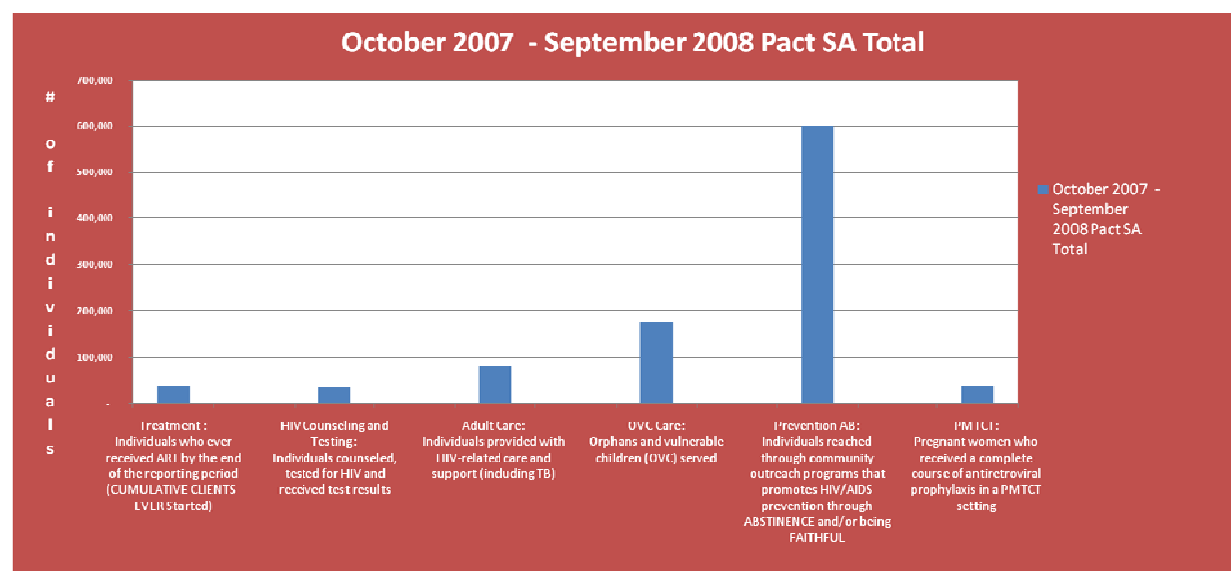
- Funded by United States Government under the President’s Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR)
- A cooperative agreement signed in Oct 2007 to manage HIV&AIDS Umbrella Grants Managements Program (UGM) in South Africa
- The UGM provides funding and capacity building support to 20 Partners (Grant Recipient) and to more than 60 CBO sub-partners active in all areas of South Africa’s response to HIV&AIDS, including prevention, treatment, care and support to those affected and infected by HIV&AIDS.
- Pact South Africa provides oversight and support through training workshops, site visits, and ongoing coaching and mentoring in areas such as program planning and management, financial management, monitoring and evaluation, grant management, and organizational development.
- Pact SA maintains a tripartite relationship with USAID and the partners ensuring that PEPFAR goals are achieved through the funding and that partners provide quality services to their beneficiaries.

#### South Africa - UNAIDS HIV Estimates

- Number of people living with HIV: 5,700,000 [4,900,000 – 6,600,000]
- Adults aged 15 to 49 prevalence rate: 18.1% [15.4% - 20.9%]
- Adults aged 15 and up living with HIV: 5,400,000 [4,700,000 – 6,200,000]
- Women aged 15 and up living with HIV: 3,200,000 [2,800,000 – 3,700,000]
- Children aged 0 to 14 living with HIV: 280,000 [230,000 – 320,000]
- Deaths due to AIDS: 350,000 [270,000 – 420,000]
- Orphans due to AIDS aged 0 to 17: 1,400,000 [1,100,000 – 1,800,000]
